The Early Years Foundation Stage

Here at North View Day Nursery we follow a set of government guidelines called the Early Years Foundation Stage.

The Early Years Foundation framework sets out the welfare standards we follow and explains what your child will be learning to support their healthy development.

Your child will be learning new skills, acquiring new knowledge and demonstrating their understanding through the 7 areas of learning development.

There are three prime areas first. These are:

- Communication & language
- Physical development
- Personal, social & emotional development

These prime areas are those most essential for your child's healthy development and future learning.

As children grow, the prime areas will help them to develop skills in the four specific areas. These are:

- Literacy
- Mathematics
- Understanding the world
- Expressive arts and design

These seven areas are used to plan your child's learning and activities. We ensure that the activities are suited to your child's unique needs.

Children in the Early Years Foundation Stage learn by playing, being active, and through creative and critical thinking which takes place both indoors and outside.

Opening Hours

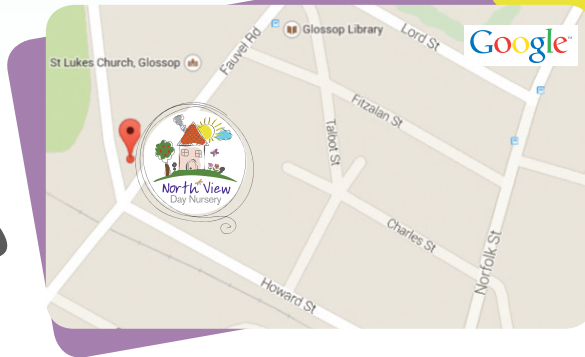
Monday to Friday 7:30-18:00,
